## **Footpath in Seavington St Mary**

A site meeting was held with a local resident and Rights of Way Officer from Somerset Council to discuss the condition and accessibility of the footpath in Seavington St Mary. It was confirmed that all existing stiles will be removed and replaced with gates to improve access. The finger post will also be cleaned, and new directional arrows will be placed on trees along the route.

## **Ranger Scheme**

Cllr Reyland reported that he will ask the Ranger to cut back the grass and bank near St Michael's Church. He will also request that the Ranger trim the top of the Church Lane splay in the direction of Ilminster, and carry out a general tidy-up following the end of the “No Mow May” initiative.
